Kiwanis accepting flag sponsorships for Field of Honor

SEMINOLE – The Kiwanis Breakfast Club of Seminole, in partnership with the city of Seminole, are now accepting flag sponsorship applications for its 2017 Field of Honor.

The Field of Honor, in its third year, will again honor past and present veterans with a patriotic display of American flags during the entire month of November on the front lawn of City Hall.

Last year, demand exceeded supply and all 176 available flags were quickly sponsored. Due to demand and a need for additional space, the Kiwanis Club has plans to expand this growing display to the Seminole campus of St. Petersburg College.

Residents, businesses and organizations of the greater Seminole area can sponsor a single or multiple 3'x 5' American flags for \$35 each. Flags are mounted on an 8' steel pole and placed in precision rows to which a custom-made, military-style streamer is attached. This streamer will be printed with the name of the veteran to be honored, military service logo, years served, the Kiwanis logo and the 2017 Field of Honor year. The streamer will be given to each flag sponsor at the conclusion of the display.
