Kiwanis Club seeking flag sponsors

SEMINOLE — The Kiwanis Breakfast Club of Seminole is accepting flag sponsorship applications for its 2020 Field of Honor, in partnership with the city of Seminole. The Field of Honor, which began with 24 flags in 2015, is now in its sixth year boasts 425 American flags.

The flags will be displayed the entire month of November in front of Seminole City Hall and adjacent post office.

Individuals, businesses and organizations can sponsor a single or multiple 3-by-5-foot American flags for \$35 each. Flags are mounted on an 8-foot steel staff and placed in precision rows. Each sponsored flag will have a colored military-style streamer attached printed with the name of the veteran being honored, years served, military service logo and the Kiwanis logo. The color of this year's streamers will be gold in recognition of the city of Seminole's 50th anniversary.
