

# Flags to be displayed as a Field of Honor at Seminole City Hall

SEMINOLE — Some 600 flags will be displayed as a Field of Honor during November in front of the Seminole City Hall, as part of a Field of Honor conducted by the Kiwanis Breakfast Club of Seminole.

Each 3-foot by 5-foot flag is sponsored by individuals, businesses and organizations and will be mounted on 8-foot steel poles. Each sponsored flag will have a colored military-style streamer attached printed with the name of the veteran being honored, years served, military service logo and the Kiwanis logo.

A one-hour Field of Honor ceremony open to the public will be held on Friday, Nov. 3, from 10-11 a.m. in the council chambers at Seminole City Hall.

The Kiwanis club is seeking volunteers to help install and remove the flag display. The flags will be erected on Wednesday, Nov. 1, and removed on Friday, Dec. 1.
