## **Nursing Scholarship**

## **REQUIREMENTS**

- Scholarship is provided for study at St. Petersburg College to a student pursuing a degree in the medical field, preferably as a registered nurse. Applicant must be enrolled in SPC Nursing Program or specified medical field.
- Application period is from April 1st through May 15th.
- Scholarship proceeds will be paid directly to SPC bookstore in the name of the scholarship student for tuition and required fees as directed by the course work of the area of medical study. The scholarship will be valid if the student meets all scholarship criterion.
- The scholarship is valid for one (1) academic year. (Fall through Summer semester)
- Candidate must remain in the nursing/medical field for the duration of the scholarship period.
- Candidate must remain free of any felony conviction.
- Candidate is encouraged to remain in contact with the Kiwanis Club of Seminole Breakfast by either attending a Club meeting or a Club event/project once a <u>semester</u>. The Club meets every Tuesday morning at 7:30 a.m. at Lurie Civic Building on the SPC Seminole Campus (9200 113th Street - Seminole, FI).
- Scholarship recipients may re-apply annually with no guarantee of renewal.
- Failure to meet or maintain listed criteria will result in the loss of the scholarship.
- Must have and maintain an <u>overall</u> GPA of 2.50 or higher (verified by SPC counselor/ provost or by an official complete transcript)
- Candidate must have current (past 12 months) and prior volunteer community service experience. Documentation of volunteer service is to be provided.
- Candidate must provide an essay not to exceed two typed pages of why you are interested in the nursing/medical field. The essay should not center on one's community service.
- Each candidate selected will be interviewed by a selection committee from the Kiwanis Club of Seminole Breakfast. Proposed date is Tuesday, June 4, 2024 beginning at 5:30pm.
