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The Kiwanis Breakfast Club of Seminole is seeking sponsorship for the 2026 Field of Honor. The sponsorship deadline is Oct. 15.

Kiwanis Club seeks 'Field of Honor' sponsors

SEMINOLE — The deadline to sponsor a flag in the 2026 Field of Honor is Oct. 15.

The Kiwanis Breakfast Club of Seminole stages the display each year to honor past and present military veterans. This year marks the 12th.

The 600 American flags will be up from Nov. 7 through Dec. 5 in front of Seminole City Hall, the adjacent post office and St. Petersburg College's Seminole campus. As of this month, 215 flags had been sponsored, the club said in a news release.

Individuals, businesses and organizations can sponsor one or more 3-by-5-foot flags for \$35 each. The flags are mounted on 8-foot steel poles and set in precision rows. Each carries a colored, military-style streamer printed with the name of the veteran being honored, years served, the military service logo and the Kiwanis logo.

When the display comes down, sponsors may keep their streamers in memory of the veterans they honored.

Flags can be sponsored by credit card, debit card or check at kiwanisseminolebreakfast.com. To pay by cash, contact club member Leah Hoffman at 727-873-7852. Sponsorship applications are also available at Seminole City Hall, the Seminole Recreation Center and the Seminole Community Library.
